RESOLUTION NO. 5

*A resolution expressing the property taxation policy of the Central Kansas District #3 with respect to financing the annual budget for 2016*

Whereas, K.S.A. 79-2925b, as amended, provides that a levy of property taxes to finance the 2016 budget of the Central Kansas District #3 exceeding the amount levied to finance the 2015 budget of the Central Kansas District #3, as adjusted to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for calendar year 2014, be authorized by a resolution adopted in advance of the adoption of a budget supported by such levy; and

Whereas, K.S.A. 79-2925b, as amended, also provides that current year revenue that is produced and attributable to the taxation of (1) new improvements, (2) increased personal property valuation other than increased valuation of oil and gas leaseholds and mobile homes, (3) property located within added jurisdictional territory, and (4) property which has changed in use shall not be considered when determining whether revenue produced from property tax has increased from the preceding year; and

Whereas, Central Kansas District #3 provides extension educational programs to the citizens of the Central Kansas District; and


Whereas, the amount of cash carryover available to fund the budget is reduced, causing an increase in the amount of property tax necessary to fund the budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Central Kansas District #3 that a levy of property taxes in support of the 2016 budget exceeding the amount levied in 2015, as adjusted pursuant to K.S.A. 79-2925b, as amended, is hereby approved.

In adopting the 2016 budget, and because less cash carryover is available to fund the budget, the Governing Body voted to increase property taxes in an amount greater than the amount levied for the 2015 budget, adjusted by the 2014 CPI for all urban consumers. 7 members voted in favor of the budget and 0 members voted against the budget.




