JOINT RESOLUTION TO CREATE JOINT RECREATION SYSTEM

RESOLUTION NO. 1-15-13

WHEREAS, Unified School District No. 355, Barton County, Kansas, is a duly organized and operating school district, as that term is defined in K.S.A. 12-1922; and

WHEREAS, the city of Ellinwood is a city as that term is defined in K.S.A. 12-1922; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-1924, a city and school district have the authority to create and operate a joint recreation system of public recreation and playgrounds; and

WHEREAS, the board of education of this school district and the governing body of this city find it necessary and advisable to establish a joint recreation system and to levy an annual tax not to exceed three (3) mills for such recreation system and to pay a portion of the principal and interest on any bonds which may be issued pursuant to K.S.A. 12-1774; and

WHEREAS, the board of education of this school district and the governing body of this city find it advisable and necessary to create a joint recreation commission to operate a system of public recreation and playgrounds and to carry out the powers and duties of such commission as delineated in K.S.A.12-1928;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 355, BARTON COUNTY, KANSAS, AND THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ELLINWOOD, BARTON COUNTY, KANSAS:

Section 1. That there is hereby created a joint recreation system to be known as the Ellinwood Recreation Commission.

Section 2. That the operation of the Recreation Commission shall be conducted by a special commission of five (5) members, pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1926.

Section 3. That this proposal be submitted for the approval by the voters of the school district at an election called and held in the manner provided by the general bond law, and the cost of the election be borne equally by the city and the school district.

ADOPTED by the Board of Education of Unified School District No. 355, Barton County, Kansas, this 14th day of January, 2013.

ADOPTED by the governing body of the City of Ellinwood, Barton County, Kansas, this 15th day of January, 2013.

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

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Pursuant to the joint resolution of the Board of Education of United School District No. 355, Barton County, Kansas, and the City of Ellinwood, Barton County, Kansas, adopted January 15th, 2013, notice is hereby given that on April 2nd, 2013, a special election will be held in the Unified School District No. 355, Barton County, Kansas for the purpose of submitting to the vote of all qualified electors of said Unified School District No. 355 the following proposition, to-wit:

"Shall the following be adopted?"

"Shall Unified School District No. 355, Barton County, Kansas, and the City of Ellinwood, Barton County, Kansas, conduct a joint recreation system for said school district and city and levy an annual tax therefore not to exceed three mills, pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1922 et seq.?"

At said special election the voting place shall be in St. Josephs Parish Center
110 W. 2nd Ellinwood, Ks

At said special election, the polls will be open for voting at 7 a.m. and shall continue until 7 p.m.

VOTING BY ELECTORS ADVANCED VOTING

Any registered voter may apply for an advanced ballot for the April 2, 2013, Question Submitted Election by contacting the County Election Officer of Barton County for an application for an advanced voting ballot. **ANYONE REQUESTING AN ADVANCED BALLOT MUST PROVIDE PHOTO ID.** Applications may also be downloaded from the County Clerk's web site at www.bartoncounty.org/clerk-ladvote.htm. Signed applications may be delivered or mailed to the County Clerk, or faxed to (620)793-1990. Upon receipt of such completed and signed application, the County Election Officer, shall provide said elector with an advanced ballot for the Question Submitted Election. **AN ELECTOR CANNOT APPLY FOR A BALLOT FOR ANOTHER VOTER.** The deadline to register to vote is March 12, 2013. An elector can vote in the office of the Barton County Clerk beginning March 13, 2013 through 12:00 (noon) on the day preceding said Question Submitted Election. An application for an advanced ballot for someone who is sick/disabled/illiterate may be filed during the regular advanced ballot application period until the close of the polls on the day of said Election. Affidavits of Assistance forms are available to assist another elector in the application and voting processes. Photo identification must be provided when voting.

The election will be conducted by the officers and/or persons provided by law for holding elections, and the method of voting will be by ballot. The election officer conducting the election will be Donna Zimmerman, County Clerk of Barton County. Election headquarters are located in the Barton County Courthouse, 1400 Main, Room 202, Great Bend, Kansas.
