Skilled work using hand-welding or flame-cutting equipment to weld or join metal components or to fill holes, indentations, or seams of fabricated metal products.

TASKS:

- Welds gas mains and valve covers, bridges and rails; repairs steam and hot water boilers, steam mains and steam pressure lines, pump cases and pump shafts.
- Installs and repairs parts on machinery, implements and equipment.
- Fabricates brackets, metal stands, hand rails, exhaust hood frames and other objects constructed from pipe, angle iron, channel rod, and flat iron.
- Designs, fabricates and modifies parts for vehicles, construction and industrial type equipment.
- Repairs stainless steel, sheet metal, and a variety of implements and appliances.

LEVELS OF WORK:

- Class Group consist of one class.

Minimum Requirements:

Six months of experience as a welder. Education may be substituted for experience as determined relevant by the agency.
