Re: Quarterly Update

The following quarterly report reflects the Civil Service Board case filings and action taken between July 15, 2016 and October 15, 2016:

A. Cases Filed Between July 15, 2016 and October 15, 2016:

B. Cases Decided and/or Disposed of:

<u>Dismissal</u> default

Corrections Officer II, Department of Corrections, Lansing Correctional Facility Appellant was dismissed for unprofessional conduct, which included being loud and belligerent with other staff and cursing at inmates, and improper use of the state computer by sending emails to his wife that contained confidential information. A prehearing conference was scheduled; appellant did not appear. A proposed default order was issued for his failure to appear to which he did not respond.

<u>Dismissal</u> withdrawal

Certified Nurse Aid I, Commission on Veterans' Affairs Office/Kansas Veterans Home Appellant was dismissed for stealing money from a resident after he was caught on a video and had blue and pink marker on both hands from tainted money placed in the resident's drawer by police. Prior to the hearing, appellant withdrew his appeal.

<u>Dismissal</u> affirmed

Engineering Technician, Department of Transportation

Appellant was dismissed after exhibiting a continuous pattern of misusing state resources, including taking non-KDOT materials from KDOT projects and taking KDOT property on KDOT time using a KDOT truck, for his own personal gain, notwithstanding numerous verbal and written warnings, and two suspensions. The Board affirmed the decision of the appointing authority dismissing appellant.
