Resolution No. 2-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD, KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Linwood was calculated as 28.253 mills by the Leavenworth County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City of Linwood will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on September 5th, 2023 allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

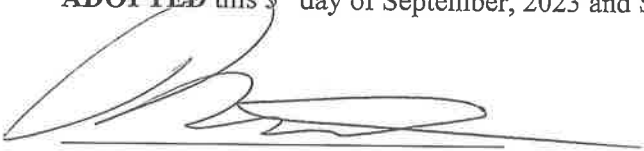
WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Linwood, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD:

The City of Linwood shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 28.253 mills.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.
