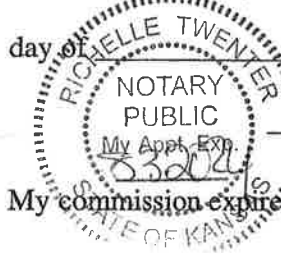

**SUMMARY**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SIDEWALK DINING DISTRICT PROVIDING FOR THE APPLICATION FOR AND GRANTING OF A SIDEWALK DINING LICENSE, ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE SAME AND CREATING REG-

ULATIONS FOR THE SAME AS ARTICLE 5 TO CHAPTER XIII OF THE CITY CODE FOR THE CITY OF RUSSELL, KANSAS

On November 17, 2020, the City of Russell, Kansas, adopted Ordinance No. 1955 which establishes a Sidewalk Dining District, the application process and requirements for the same by which restaurants within the Sidewalk Dining District can be licensed to extend their premises onto the City's sidewalk.
