Resolution 22-23 RNR Adoption

A RESOLUTION OF THE SATANTA RECREATION COMMISSION TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the **Satanta Recreation Commission** was calculated as **1.216** mills by the Haskell County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the **Satanta Recreation Commission** will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on **September 14, 2022** allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and




WHEREAS, the Governing Body of **Satanta Recreation Commission** having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF SATANTA RECREATION COMMISSION:


Satanta Recreation Commission shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of **1.216** mills.
