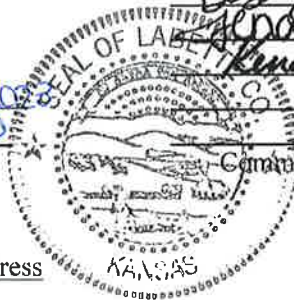

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALTAMONT RECREATION COMMISSION, LOCATED IN ALTAMONT KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the Altamont Recreation Commission was calculated as 0.951 mills by the Labette County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the Altamont Recreation Commission will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on August 21, 2023 allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Altamont Recreation Commission, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE ALTAMONT RECREATION COMMISSION:

The Altamont Recreation Commission may levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 0.951 mills.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.



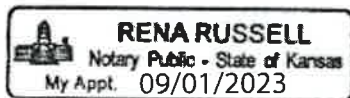
