Whereas, budgeting, taxing and service level decisions for all township services are the responsibility of the township board; and

Whereas, Twp 6 provides essential services to protect the safety and well being of the citizens of the township; and

Whereas, the cost of provision of these services continues to increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Twp 6 of Rooks County, Kansas that is our desire to notify the public of increased property taxes to finance the 2016 Twp 6 budget as defined above.
