The following quarterly report reflects the Civil Service Board case filings and action taken between July 15, 2017 and October 15, 2017:

A. Cases Filed Between July 15, 2017 and October 15, 2017:

10-day suspension, Department of Corrections, Wichita Parole Office, filed September 22, 2017

3-day suspension, Kansas Commission of Veterans' Affairs Office, Kansas Veterans Home, filed September 26, 2017

B. Cases Decided and/or Disposed of:

Dismissal withdrawn

Kansas Commission of Veterans' Affairs Office, Kansas Veterans Home Certified Nurse Aid II. Appellant was dismissed for allegedly abusing a resident. Appellant withdrew her appeal.

<u>Dismissal</u> withdrawn

Department of Revenue

Driver's License Examiner. Appellant was dismissed for allegedly failing to comply with KDOR policies and failing to maintain a harmonious work relationship by being disrespectful, unprofessional, and insubordinate. Appellant withdrew her appeal.

<u>Dismissal</u> affirmed

Department for Aging and Disabilities Services/Parson State Hospital and Training Center Mental Health Developmental Disability Technician. Appellant was dismissed for repeatedly exhibiting unprofessional behavior towards female employees. The Board affirmed the action of the appointing authority dismissing appellant.
