**EXECUTIVE DIRECTIVE NO. 05-357**

**Authorizing A Personnel Transaction**

By virtue of the authority vested in the Governor as the head of the Executive Branch of the State of Kansas, the following transaction is hereby authorized:

The request of Jack Rickerson, Director of the Division of Personnel Services, to provide a 10.0 percent retention incentive for commissioned law enforcement officers at the University of Kansas Medical Center in the following law enforcement classifications: University Police Officer, University Police Corporal, University Police Sergeant, University Police Detective, University Police Lieutenant, and University Police Captain is hereby approved, effective June 6, 2004. The portion of Executive Directive No. 04-351 relating to a retention incentive for commissioned law enforcement officers at the University of Kansas Medical Center is hereby rescinded, effective immediately.

I have conferred with the Secretary of Administration, the Director of the Budget, the Director of Personnel Services, and members of my staff, and I have determined that the requested action is appropriate.
