EXECUTIVE DIRECTIVE NO. 01-312

Authorizing a Personnel Transaction
and
Authorizing Certain Expenditures

By virtue of the authority vested in the Governor as the head of the Executive Branch of the State of Kansas, the following transactions are hereby authorized:

The request of Bobbi Mariani, Director of the Division of Personnel Services, to provide an 8.0 percent retention incentive for commissioned law enforcement officers at the University of Kansas Medical Center in the following law enforcement classifications: University Police Officer, University Police Corporal, University Police Sergeant, University Police Detective, and University Police Lieutenant, is hereby approved, effective June 10, 2001, and will remain in effect for a period of up to three years or until the Division of Personnel Services has determined that the retention incentive is no longer necessary, whichever occurs first.

I have conferred with the Secretary of Administration, the Director of the Budget, the Director of Personnel Services, and members of my staff, and I have determined that the requested action is appropriate.

Pursuant to the authority of the Department of Agriculture to receive and expend federal funds, and pursuant to the authority granted the Governor by Section 176(a) of Chapter 144 of the 2001 Session Laws of Kansas, approval is hereby given to the Department of Agriculture for expenditure in FY 2002 of monies in the federal account entitled "FEMA Stream Mapping Initiatives—Federal Fund."

I have conferred with the Director of the Budget and members of my staff, and I have determined that the guidelines set forth in KSA 75-3711 and 75-3711c have been applied and that none of the foregoing actions exceeds the limitations contained therein.
