EXECUTIVE DIRECTIVE NO. 01-314

Authorizing Certain Expenditures and Authorizing Certain Personnel Transactions

By virtue of the authority vested in the Governor as the head of the Executive Branch of the State of Kansas, the following transactions are hereby authorized:

Pursuant to the authority of the Department of Agriculture to receive and expend federal funds, and pursuant to the authority granted the Governor by Section 176(a) of Chapter 144 of the *2001 Session Laws of Kansas*, approval is hereby given to the Department of Agriculture for expenditure in FY 2002 of monies in the federal account entitled "Specialty Crop Block Grant—Federal Fund."

Pursuant to the authority of the Kansas Corporation Commission to receive and expend federal funds, and pursuant to the authority granted the Governor by Section 176(a) of Chapter 144 of the *2001 Session Laws of Kansas*, approval is hereby given to the Kansas Corporation Commission for expenditure in FY 2002 of monies in the federal fund account entitled "Utility Related Grants—Federal Fund."

I have conferred with the Director of the Budget and members of my staff, and I have determined that the guidelines set forth in KSA 75-3711 and 75-3711c have been applied and that none of the foregoing actions exceeds the limitations contained therein.

The request of Bobbi Mariani, Director of the Division of Personnel Services, to abolish the job classes Motor Vehicle Registration Clerk I, Motor Vehicle Registration Clerk II, and Motor Vehicle Registration Clerk III from the Kansas Civil Service is hereby approved, effective with the beginning date of the next pay period following the signing of this executive directive.

The request of Bobbi Mariani, Director of the Division of Personnel Services, to establish the new job classes of Vehicle Identification Number Inspector at pay grade 15, Vehicle Identification Number Inspector Lead at pay grade 17, and Vehicle Identification Number Inspector Supervisor at pay grade 20 in the Kansas Civil Service and to provide a 2.5 percent increase or the equivalent of one step, not to exceed step 15, is hereby approved, effective with the beginning date of the next pay period following the signing of this executive directive.

I have conferred with the Secretary of Administration, the Director of the Budget, the Director of Personnel Services, and members of my staff, and I have determined that the requested action is appropriate.
